From initial client contact through closing a transaction, our analysts are an integral part of the transaction process; researching, valuing, pricing, marketing, and structuring transactions.

The position requires a minimum two year commitment. Depending on individual performance, many analysts are invited to stay for a third year. Superior performers are often promoted to the associate level at the end of their third year.

Training

The Analyst Training Program, which begins in mid - July, provides a five-week introduction and orientation to the firm and its capabilities. The curriculum includes coursework in accounting, financial analysis, modeling, valuation, and Excel. The program is thorough, combining the substance of a much larger bank's training program with the personal attention found in a seminar.
